Below we are listing! important! items that must be followed in order to ensure a successful and smooth school year for everyone:

- The school day hours are: 8:45 AM-3:45 PM.
- Our drop off and pick up door location will be at Door #1/Main Entrance.
- If your child arrives at 8:52 AM they are considered tardy and must receive a tardy slip from the front desk. Tardies are noted on your child's attendance record.
- If your child will be absent you must call the main office to notify of the absence and a note must be provided the following day with a reason for absence.
- It is important that your child attends school every day. Students who have attendance of lower than 80% will not be allowed to go on field trips or participate in special attendance events. Valid excuses for absence are sickness (with fever, rash, vomit and/or diarrhea), death in the immediate family, religious practices or family emergency. Hearst values excellent attendance and children with perfect attendance will be allowed to participate in special school events.
- If your child is feeling ill with the following: cold, cough, vomiting, diarrhea, ear pain, toothache, fever, body pains, etc, please keep them home! We strive for your child to learn comfortably and prevent others from becoming sick.
- Breakfast in the classroom begins at 8:45AM and ends at 9:10AM.
- Each child receives breakfast, lunch, and a snack. A home lunch is not necessary but if you do send a lunch, <u>PLEASE DO NOT SEND chips. cookies. anything</u> that has nuts or is sugary. WE HIGHLY ENCOURAGE a healthy lunch.
- Children should be wearing gym shoes with <u>velcro straps or slip-on shoes</u>. Shoes with laces can become distracting during carpet time. Please support us in this matter.
- Children receive quiet time during the middle of the school day. Your child may bring a small blanket to use for this time of the day. Blankets will be sent home every two weeks in order for them to be washed at home. Please do not send any stuffed animals or any other items from home that can become lost or be a

distraction during the school day.

- Students must wear the school uniform. The uniform is navy blue pants and a navy blue shirt.
- Children have accidents whether it be a bathroom accident or a food or drink spill. We ask you to please add an extra pair of pants, underwear, socks, and shirts in your child's backpack in a labeled ziplock bag.
- At home, there should be a supply box with crayons, pencils, glue, and scissors for your child's homework activities.
- During the school year, field trips and classroom events will take place. In order to attend such events please go to cpsvolunteers.org to sign up as a level II parent volunteer. Please ask us if you need help with the application process.
